



Maigret Sundays, October 5 - November 9, 2025 on PBS

Descriptions

Season

Chief Inspector Maigret and his team of maverick but loyal detectives, "Les Maigrets," solve a series of complex crimes in Paris. Maigret's unconventional methods and unique sense of justice put him at odds with his superiors and the judicial system he is supposed to represent. Maigret must outwit some of Paris's most cunning and violent criminals, while dealing with his own troubled past.

Episode One: The Lazy Burglar - Part One Sunday, October 5, 2025 at 9/8c on PBS

Maigret is investigating a series of bank robberies that have been plaguing Paris. He ignores his superior's orders and turns his attention to the brutal murder of a burglar, Honoré Cuendet. His decision to juggle both cases puts his career in jeopardy, but he continues to seek justice for the slain thief. Just as he is closing in on Cuendet's killers, the bank robbers strike again.

Episode Two: The Lazy Burglar - Part Two Sunday, October 12, 2025 at 9/8c on PBS

Despite being demoted for losing his only lead in the bank robberies case, Maigret continues to pursue justice for Honoré Cuendet and his loved ones. By anticipating the bank robbers' next move, Maigret wins himself the chance to confront and expose Honoré's killers. Maigret appears to have won a double victory, but then he realizes that the heists were only a part of the robbers' larger master plan.











Episode Three: Maigret's Failure - Part One Sunday, October 19, 2025 at 9/8c on PBS

Maigret and his team's search for a missing social media influencer is thrown into disarray when he is ordered to investigate death threats received by a billionaire businessman, Ferdinand Fumal. Fumal and Maigret grew up together and have a difficult history. As Maigret struggles to balance both cases, Fumal's bullying forces him to make a decision that he will regret.

Episode Four: Maigret's Failure - Part Two Sunday, October 26, 2025 at 9/8c on PBS

As Maigret reels from his failure to protect the billionaire Fumal, he also suffers a devastating blow in his personal life. With pressure mounting to resolve the case of the missing social media influencer, Maigret digs deep into Fumal's circle of acquaintances in order to understand him better. He uncovers an unexpected side to Fumal which makes him reevaluate the man and their shared history.

Episode Five: Maigret Comes Home - Part One Sunday, November 2, 2025 at 9/8c on PBS

A student is stabbed to death in the street. Maigret and Cavre disagree over the killer's motives. As the investigations proceed in different directions, Maigret digs into the killer's psychology and tries to provoke him into making contact. But his priorities suddenly shift when Countess Sophie calls to say that she fears for her life. Maigret is left facing an impossible decision.

Episode Six: Maigret Comes Home - Part Two Sunday, November 9, 2025 at 9/8c on PBS

Tragedy strikes in Saint-Fiacre, shocking Maigret to the core. Maigret begins to peel back the deceit and corruption that ruined Sophie's life. He enlists her son Maurice to expose the villains who have plundered the Saint-Fiacre estate for years. Back in Paris, Maigret's conversations with the killer have unintended and terrifying consequences, and it's Madame Maigret who is most at risk.
